General Comments
<p>Licensing staff arrived at the licensed facility to conduct a follow-up license renewal inspection.</p> <p>The administrator relayed to the inspector that the building is now hornet free and the children can now access the gym area to play when needed.</p> <p>The child-to-staff ratio exceeded what is required according to the Early Childhood Services Act. The educator heard the educator give the children a "5-minute warning" before transitioning from one activity to another. Licensing staff observed the educators counting the children and then communicating the change in child-to-staff ratio with the other educators.</p> <p>While the children were waiting for their afternoon snack, they searched for toys that the educators hid in one of the classrooms upstairs. Licensing staff observed the children laughing and working together to find the toys.</p> <p>After snack and free play activities the children went outdoors to play and to perform a science experiment.</p> <p>Outdoor play equipment was brought out to the outdoor environment for the children to engage with.</p> <p>Throughout the follow-up license renewal inspection, licensing staff heard only positive child guidance techniques used with the children receiving care. The educators were observed engaging with the children during the inspection.</p>
