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General Comments
<p>Upon arrival of licensing staff, the children were engaged in free play. Some children were playing with dolls, and others were colouring. The educators greeted the children as they arrived for the day. An educator took out yoga mats and sensory-friendly ear protection for a child that wanted to relax. The educators were engaging in conversation with the children. Water bottles were out and available, and cups were available for those who did not have a bottle. The educators gave a 10-minute prompt before snack. The children then started cleaning up and lined up by the door. The children and an educator walked down to the washroom to wash their hands. Another educator stayed upstairs to supervise the children as they returned upstairs and sat down for snack. The educators were seen talking to each other and keeping each other updated with walkie-talkies. The educators sat down with the children and ate snack with them.</p> <p>After snack, the children returned to their play. Some played with the kitchen, cars, and dolls, and others coloured. The educators cleaned the tables and gave a 10-minute prompt for the activity. The children cleaned up their toys and sat at the table. For the activity, the children were going to have the opportunity to build structures with marshmallows and dry spaghetti noodles. The educators sat with and helped the children. The children were seen using their imagination and building houses, gym equipment, people, and more. After the activity, the children washed their hands before engaging in free play. The educators gave a 10-minute prompt before it would be time to go down to the gym before lunch. The children cleaned up, grabbed their water bottles, and lined up by an educator. They all walked down together, and the educators brought the backpack and the attendance sheet. The children ran around the gym and played with balls before playing gym games. The children and educators played "Banana Tag", "Dog Tag", and "Why are you in my backyard". An educator refilled water bottles and encouraged water breaks. The children were heard laughing as they played the games.</p> <p>The indoor environment was clean with resources accessible to the children. Various materials are available such as books, art supplies, blocks, games, dolls, and a kitchen. Artwork was posted on the walls in the hallway. Child and staff files were checked and found to be complete. The educators were attentive to the children. Only positive child guidance was observed.</p>
