Comments: During the Licence Renewal Inspection, licensing staff observed two holes in the wall located in the cubby area on the lower level of the facility. One of the holes contained exposed wiring leading into the wall and was covered with duct tape. This area must be repaired, and the wiring must be appropriately enclosed to maintain a safe environment for children and to prevent potential access to electrical components. Licensing staff also observed a second hole in the wall that had been covered with duct tape. This hole must also be repaired to ensure the physical environment remains safe and well maintained.			

General Comments
Licensing staff arrived at the licensed facility to conduct the annual Licence Renewal Inspection. Upon arrival in the morning, children were still being dropped off for the day. At the time of the inspection, educators and children were engaged in free play activities within the outdoor play environment. When it was time for morning snack, educators prepared the children for the transition indoors. Educators were observed counting the children multiple times prior to transitioning inside. Licensing staff also observed educators effectively communicating with one another using walkie-talkies to ensure all children were accounted for before entering the building. Following morning snack, the children engaged in centre-based play activities. In Classroom 1, learning centres were set up to include Barbies and accessories, Lego, tabletop activities such as puzzles, card games, and bracelet making, mark-making activities with paper, markers, and a whiteboard, as well as books and Magna-Tiles. The children were observed freely accessing the available materials and participating in activities based on their interests. In Classroom 2, children participated in an arts and crafts activity using salt dough, shells, and paint. While all children were provided with the same materials, they were encouraged to create unique projects based on their individual ideas and creativity. Upon completion of the activity, children were provided with choices for their next activity before returning outdoors for free play until lunchtime.

General Comments

Licensing staff reviewed all staff and child files and found them to be complete and contain the required documentation.

Licensing staff had a discussion with the Program Onsite Supervisor regarding the implementation of a Monthly Outdoor Safety Checklist to further support the safety of children while playing in the outdoor environment. The Program Onsite Supervisor informed licensing staff that educators currently conduct daily safety inspections of the outdoor play environment each morning before children access the space; however, these inspections are not formally documented. Moving forward, the Program Onsite Supervisor will maintain a documented Monthly Outdoor Safety Checklist to support compliance with the Early Childhood Services Act and ensure ongoing monitoring of the outdoor play environment.
