General Comments							
When I arrived for the monitoring visit, children were playing outdoors. It was a beautiful, sunny morning.							
Children enjoyed playing on the playground equipment and educators remained close to the structure to help children when needed and engage in their imaginative play.							
It was warm outside and all children had their water bottles outside.

While the children were content and happy playing on the playground equipment, it was noted that there were no materials or toys for them to play with today. The educator did state that they do bring out bubbles, shovels, and buckets some days. These materials along with other items like balls, trucks, etc. need to be made available daily. Children need to have easy access to them similar to the indoor environment.

During my visit, all educators present displayed positive child guidance. I observed time warnings for transitions, gentle reminders, playing down at their level, and speaking in a respectful tone.

When the children came indoors, indoor shoes were put on and all children washed hands. Once the children had finished snack, they had different activities. Children colored, played with cars and trucks on the mat, used rhythm sticks to sing along with a song and had time in the gym. In the gym there were various stations set up. There was coloring, hoola hoops, a wooden train set, plastic bowling pins, soccer nets and hopper balls.

Attendance records were checked and all children have been signed in and out and absent codes were being used appropriately.
