<p>General Comments</p> <p>Following a visit to the afterschool program on December 7 a renewal inspection visit was conducted with the preschool program on December 8. No further non-compliances were noted during this time.</p> <p>At the start of the inspection on December 8, the children were preparing to go outdoors after having completed a craft earlier in the morning. During the transition to outdoors, staff encouraged independence but were available to support children when needed with dressing appropriately for the weather. They brought varied toys out for the children to play and also suggested games to the children such as hide and seek. The educators took natural opportunities where they arose to teach children about nature such as, discussing how rain makes mud when the children saw mud puddles and pointing out birds near the play area to the children.</p> <p>Staff sat with children at their level and talked to them to support them with working through their challenging emotions with peer conflicts around things like sharing and taking turns.</p>
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General Comments

After an hour of outdoor play, the group returned indoors where educators prompted removing outerwear and handwashing, encouraging as much independence as possible as the proceeded to their morning snack.
