<p>General Comments</p> <p>Licensing staff arrived at the facility to conduct a monitoring inspection. The summer programming has begun, and the educators were telling me about their main theme, which is Pixar, so Group 1, the younger school age children, are the Toy Story group and Group 2, the older school age children, are the Monsters Incorporated. Each of the weeks has a sub theme and today's week is one thing versus another such as colours; red versus blue or prey versus predators etc. The younger group were in the craft room playing a game called Presto Chango where they choose a child and everyone memorizes what they look like and then they go out of the room and change something and everyone has to guess what it is when they come back. The children all had a turn and were very engaged and sometimes emotional about being correct in their answers which gave the educators an opportunity to help them self-regulate, play in a group, participate fairly and to understand rules, fair play and taking turns etc. Staff were very kind and respectful with the children and well trained in leadership and their roles.</p> <p>The older school age children walked down to Reading St. Park where they could spread out in a large field space and play more organized larger scale games. The children chose many of their activities and are given a variety of choices. Every week there is a cooking activity and today they were choosing whether to have Pizza versus Tacos. The programming is diverse and varied and there are lots of interesting activities taking place along with the usual arts and crafts, lego and building materials, and balls and games to name a few. The children's paintings of owls from yesterday were drying on a rack and their artwork was displayed on the walls.</p> <p>The parent board was set up in the main entryway with all necessary postings present. Licensing staff reviewed 10 staff files and 10 child files, and they were all up to date and complete. The facility was clean and bright with lots of materials available and the sound proofing added to the gym has made a positive difference to the noise levels. The facility had extra staff in each group, and it really helped the programs flow easily and allowed staff to meet more of the children's individual needs.</p>
