<p>Licensing staff arrived at facility and found many positive changes to the environment especially in the school age area. New materials have been purchased, the walls have been painted and the padded flooring has been removed. The space has been set up with many learning centres and activities for the children to do. Educators have been working in all areas to ensure an increased quality of the overall centre.</p> <p>The educators were able to demonstrate that their planning has been a process derived from the interests of the children. The children's work was displayed throughout the facility and documentation was seen in forms of learning stories, webbing, charts and pictures.</p> <p>As discussed, please develop a more detailed written emergency plan for staff members which outlines staff members responsibilities, lists items to be removed in an emergency (example, first aid kit, emergency contact information and attendance records. The written evacuation plan must show the evacuation routes and include an address of where you would go in case you could not return back to the facility.</p> <p>Staff members must:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • know the emergency plan and how to safely evacuate children in an emergency situation • understand their responsibilities • know how to physically remove children from the building, in particular, how to evacuate infants
