General Comments
<p>Each of the rooms are set up with learning centres and a variety of materials to promote learning and choice. The children were observed moving freely throughout the room and were engaged with their peers and educators. The educators were observed at the children's level, having conversations and playing with them. Child guidance was used as necessary with gentle direction and in a way that promoted problem solving. Only positive child guidance was seen at the time of my visit.</p> <p>The educators are using planning sheets that are separated in different categories including literacy, sensory, math/science, creativity and social skills. In these categories the educators placed different kinds of activities that may be introduced to the children. I suggested to the Director to use a journal so that the educators could demonstrate how these ideas were based on the interests of the children. The Director had already considered this idea and plans to move forward with it.</p> <p>Learning stories that are posted throughout the facility demonstrate child led learning. An example of this was posted in the entrance of the facility where an educator had given each child an opportunity to take pictures and allow everyone to see the world through their eyes. This idea was formed from one of the children making a camera from lego.</p> <p>The children's art with their own quotes attached to them were visible in many of the classrooms. One of the educators is forming portfolios for the children which will include their individual artwork and learning stories.</p> <p>The children are learning to stay connected to their community. One of the educators informed me that the children had completed a bottle drive and the money was going to be donated to the National Conservancy of</p>
