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General Comments
Licensing staff arrived at 8:15am for a monitoring inspection. Upon arriving the children in the 2 year old classroom were inside engaged in free play activities such as coloring and stacking plastic cups. The educators were sitting on the floor at the children's level. The educators were heard asking open ended questions to the children and praising them for sharing the cups to stack. The children of the other age groups were observed playing in the larger of the two playgrounds. The children were playing in the sandbox and had access to a variety of accessories located in large storage bins. Other children were observed playing in the dramatic playhouse with an educator. Another educator was observed preparing a water table invitation. The playground was clean and presented no safety hazards. A large portion of the playground was naturally shaded due to the trees. An educator was observed kneeling to speak to a small group of children about sharing materials at the water table. The educator spoke softly to the children and asked them questions on how to resolve their material conflict. The educator then ensured that additional materials were added to the water table to allow more children to participate. Later, a dinosaur activity was prepared outside for the children. Once completed the educator invited some children to play and took some pictures to document the children's learning and daily activities. Once it was time for their morning snack, a verbal prompt was given to the children to line up and wash their hands while outside. Proper handwashing was completed with the water hose and soap, and the picnic tables were sanitized before the children sat down to eat. The children were supervised by the educators as they ate. During this time, the school aged children and educators were observed playing in the small field behind the childcare facility, near the walking trail entrance. Please ensure that the educators bring their first aid bags while in the field area. After eating, an educator brought out playdough and accessories for the children to access while outside. Daily attendance was taken for all classrooms. Five child records were verified and found to be complete. The parent information board was verified and found to be complete. The children's personal belongings were properly stored.
