## **General Comments**

On the morning of my monitoring visit, I observed children playing outside and one group went for a walk. There were numerous materials for the children to play with and the educators positioned themselves around the space to ensure proper supervision. Children were playing with trucks, balls, and digging in the sand. Some older children were doing glitter tattoos with their educators and this was a popular activity.

Educators have worked hard to continue organizing and the rooms are continuing to be set up for the new school year. Materials have been well organized and new art work is being added. Many educators are switching out their plastic bins for some baskets and this is a nice change. The furniture placement in the rooms has also changed and looks good. Defined areas for reading, block creations and dramatic play are evident.

I heard many positive comments from educators and observed patience and kindness.

The downstairs rooms have been painted and decluttered. New flooring is being installed soon.

## General Comments

Lunch today was hash brown casserole, green beans, apples and milk.

While verifying files, it was noted that 3 files of the ones that were checked are missing medicare numbers and 4 of the files that were checked are missing immunization records.

It was noted that artificial turf is being used in lieu of a rug in some areas. I will be checking with Public Health to see if this is an approved surface to use indoors. The concern is the difficulty it could pose to be properly and thoroughly cleaned.
