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General Comments

Many changes since my last inspections.

Most rooms have been painted with a light gray color which provides a more calming and natural tone to the rooms and the afterschool room has new floor.

All rooms have been cleaned, decluttered and re-organized.

New shelves, new materials and new furniture has been added in all rooms.

In the preschool rooms, the new materials include loose parts, more natural elements such has growing pots, seas shells, wood, items for fine motor such has twist and turn wood building blocks. Some rooms also have new centres set up with new materials, many new area rugs, bookshelves, and new /pretend play areas. The rooms are organized and welcoming.

The preschool children were observed doing different activities throughout the day such has playing with snow indoors, painting, crafts, playing with the indoor sand box, pretend play with dolls, pretend play with construction hats, circle time, reading books and building using blocks. The 3/4-year-old were observed practicing words and sounds.

General Comments

Positive child guidance was observed such has gentle reminders about walking, sitting while eating and washing their hands. Educators were also observed talking to the children at their level.

There is evidence of purposely planned programing and there are learning stories and children's art on the walls.

The 4/5-year-old were watching a movie after lunch. The movie was Monster Inc. Use of television in not recommended and should not be used to fill gapes during the day. In addition, the program and/or movie should support the curriculum. The educator advised Monster Inc was chosen as the letter of the week is M.

The afterschool room has been completely redone with new paint, floors, shelves, storage containers such has crates and new materials. The children have a reading corner with an area rug and some seating, books and puzzles, a dramatic play corner with costumes, a building corner with blocks of different shapes and sizes, some train building sets, a science corner and other toys and materials for all interests. The children are also growing vegetables in pots.

When the afterschool children arrived, they were asked to wash their hands, had lunch and then gathered in a circle to read a book.

The outdoor space was inspected and meets regulation. Some aspects were not inspected such has protective surfacing due to the snow. New play materials were also added outside such has a treehouse, climbing structures and a music corner. Some of the children were sliding with saucers.

The Centre also has a new system they can share information, learning stories and communicate with parents.
