Comments: When licensing staff arrived at the licensed facility to conduct a Follow-Up Licence Renewal Inspection, it was observed that mark-making and craft materials continued to be inaccessible to children enrolled in the infant classroom. When this concern was discussed with educators, licensing staff were informed that additional mark-making materials had been ordered and were expected to arrive the following week. The licensed facility must ensure that mark-making and craft materials are readily accessible to infants so they can independently access and explore these materials throughout the day, as developmentally appropriate. To support compliance with this requirement, licensing staff will contact the curriculum consultant assigned to the facility to provide guidance to educators on creating distinct play centres within the classroom, including a dedicated mark-making and creative arts area that promotes children's engagement, exploration, and independent access to materials.

General Comments
Licensing staff arrived at the licensed facility to conduct a Follow-Up License Renewal Inspection. Child-to-staff ratios were calculated in all classrooms and were found to be compliant with the requirements of the Early Childhood Services Act.

General Comments

Educators in each classroom were actively engaged with the children at their level. During afternoon snack, educators sat at the tables with the children, fostering meaningful interactions and supporting a positive, relationship-based learning environment.

Licensing staff will contact the Early Learning Consultant for Curriculum assigned to the facility to provide additional support to educators in the infant room. The consultant will assist educators in implementing a mark-making and craft area that infants can independently access throughout the day, promoting opportunities for exploration, creativity, and learning.
