<p>Monitoring visit performed</p> <p>Covid Recovery Phase Guidelines are being followed i.e. daily log sheet, cleaning schedule, signage for entrance requirements etc.</p> <p>The Operator provided staff updates and this facility is meeting the educational requirements. Please email a copy of the educators ECE certificate as per discussed.</p> <p>Children observed getting ready for outdoor play during my visit. It was discussed that beginning outdoor play at an earlier time would allow children to enjoy morning and afternoon. It is a juggle as this facility also offers a school age program and they use the same outdoor play area. With the new covid rules, bubbles must use outdoor play space at separate times, with exception of babies who have their own outdoor play area.</p> <p>Lots of wonderful changes to outdoor play area observed. I would recommend you add pea gravel to areas where puddles have formed.</p> <p>It was also suggested that cloths only be used once per cleaning in the programming rooms or resort to using paper towel.</p> <p>Educators were observed providing assistance with getting ready for outdoor play.</p>
