## **General Comments**

During the annual inspection the licensing staff observed evidence of learning with multiple forms of documentation in all classrooms. When observing in the infant room the babies were engaging in finger paint with glitter and the babies were exploring the properties of the paint and glitter.

During the annual inspection it was noted that a number of children's files are missing Medicare numbers, and the names of Medical Practitioners or Doctors listed in the child's profile. Also, all children 's files are required to have the names of two emergency contacts in case of having to reach parents for emergency reasons. Please ensure these documents are completed and updated in the children's files.

All cleaning supplies need to be locked so that children do not have access to these toxic products. Please ensure all products remain in a locked cabinet at all times.

During the annual inspection the licensing staff noted that the kitchen area where the knives and cleaning products are being stored does not have a locked door. Please ensure that knives and toxic products are locked (with a key) at all times so the children cannot access these items.

When inspecting the outdoor play area it was noted that the fence and the gate from one space to the other the gate is not secure. It can easily be pushed open which is a safety concern. Please secure this gate. Also, it was noted that the storage box at the back of the playground where the natural sand box is located the ground is uneven and a hole has formed under the storage box. Please level the ground out in this area.

The climbing walls do not have enough protective surfacing and this will need to be corrected by the spring time. In the meantime please do not allow the children to access these until you are able to add to the protective surfacing.

The Quality Assurance Monitor will check in the Spring during a monitoring visit with regards to adding to the protective surfacing around the climbing walls.

While we care for children we need to remember to use a very nurturing tone and we should encourage and not make demands on children that we care for.
