<p>General Comments</p> <p>Monitoring visit</p> <p>Monitoring visit performed</p> <p>Administrative records were reviewed during my visit - attendance, infant toddler records, fire drills etc and all in order. Return after exclusion forms are being completed with children returning with a communicable disease. These are being documented and signed off so parents are aware.</p> <p>Upon arrival, lots of play stations observed in the outdoor play space - new workbench and the Operator has also purchased a composter bin. The Operator has some ideas for toddler outdoor play area - creating a beach house theme. She also is trying to decide how she will address the muddy section in this space, though the children have enjoyed it this spring. It will dry up eventually and is not an issue except when it rains and in the spring comes water and attraction for bugs. Please keep the gate closed leading to the second floor at all times when children are outdoor playing.</p> <p>Some observations - more books need to be on display in the 2 year old class. Not a lot of selection available for children to choose from. The children's lunch bags should be zipped closed between snacks and lunch to keep food cold. I observed lunch bags opened during my visit in this class..</p> <p>Lots of current programming posted throughout the centre. The fours and school age group had science east visiting and they did a presentation on robots. Children enjoyed this presentation. The ASP rooms are bright, and inviting. Lots of wonderful sensory materials to select from.</p> <p>All children were observed in outdoor play, later during my visit babies were finishing lunch and going for a nap, other children were observed eating lunch and either going for nap or older preschoolers got dressed for outdoor play.</p> <p>Appropriate child guidance observed. Educator's were observed engaged and eating lunch with the children also.</p> <p>One observation - time for small outdoor toys to be cleaned and scrubbed including the ones stored in the bins.</p>
