<p>General Comments</p> <p>Monitoring visit performed today.</p> <p>Upon arrival attendance records were reviewed. Educators are documenting children and staff arrivals and departures. The ratio was not in accordance with the Regulations on the day of my visit. The staff child ratio was not maintained in the preschool age group in the AM. This was corrected during my visit today with the addition of 2 staff arriving mid morning. Staff child ratio must also be maintained in the outdoor play area. Children were observed playing outdoors during my visit.</p> <p>Please post illness notice at both entry doors in the cubby area. Educators are following appropriate guidelines for tracking and managing illness and parents are also notifying the centre when children are sick and keeping them at home. No cases of diarrhea in the centre, however if you were to have 2 or more cases, please notify Public Health as this could be the beginning of a possible outbreak of illness. With vomiting, children should remain away for 24 hours after the last vomit episode.</p> <p>Educators are either enrolled or have completed the 90 hour intro to ECE or have confirmed registration to take ECE Certificate. This facility will be meeting the training requirements for July 2020. Nice to see that Educators are posting their training diplomas.</p>

General Comments

Appropriate child guidance practices were observed during my visit. Staff arrange the indoor and outdoor play space so children can move freely between activities. They document children's learning experiences and this is evident when they post learning stories in the classroom at children's eye level.
The 2's were involved in puzzles, music, lego, trucks and loving books. The classrooms are very welcoming. the preschool age group are gearing up for Valentines day celebration - reading stories and singing songs.
Maybe a bench in the cubby area would be helpful with getting children dressed.
The chair in the 2's room reading corner and the one in the preschool/afterschool program rooms needs repaired as the cushion is ripped and/or torn and difficult to clean.
