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| <p>General Comments</p> <p>Monitoring visit performed. Covid guidelines are followed and visitors are tracked on a log sheet. Administrative and staff records reviewed and all in order. Attendance is documented daily. Upon arrival, children were getting ready to go outside to the outdoor play area. One group remained indoors and they were involved in water play. The outdoor play area is inviting and provides lots of opportunities for children to explore their environment. The educators have incorporated the curriculum outside and use it for a variety of play experiences- quiet areas, music area, climbing, swinging etc. Children were involved in sand play, observed swinging and building with lego, practicing O'Canada. The programming rooms are bright, organized so materials are easily accessible to children which allows children to use their imagination and explore a variety of sensory materials. They made individual apple pies this past week. Lots of wonderful current learning stories posted through the centre. School age program area has a variety of fun, age appropriate materials, toys and equipment - puzzles, table games, oodles of books, reading corner, science center etc. Children were observed eating lunch and many going for a naptime. The older preschool children were observed going outdoors after eating lunch. School age children were observed arriving off school bus. It is important that educators arrange outdoor play opportunities at different times so preschool and school age children age are not in the space at the same time. This is not the regular routine. Educators were observed engaged, providing guidance and assisting children. Supervision was appropriate.</p> |
