General Comments

Children were observed during circle time, outdoor play and at lunch.

In the 4's room, circle time was a balance of songs, discussions, stories and gross motor activities. The educator ensured that all children had turns to share in the discussions and participate in the action games. Bins of art materials are labelled, and two "clotheslines" are low on two walls to display photos of winter related items such as igloos, skates and winter clothing. Trays for quiet time with activities were prepared on the counter for after lunch.

The 3-year-old group sang songs and clapped the letters of their names during their circle time. An ABC book was also read, and the educator incorporated the children's names. A winter sensory bin was set up and bulletin boards are low for the children to see with family photos.

Outside, this group liked playing in the snow, creating cakes for their educator. The educator engaged with them in their imaginative play and was observed using a potato masher to loosen up the hard packed snow for the children to use.

In the two-year-old room, one educator heated up the two-year olds lunches while the other educator read a book to the children, asking lots of questions and keeping the children engaged during this busy time.

All the rooms have accessible materials, and the spaces are clean, organized and well-maintained.

All educators displayed positive child guidance throughout the monitoring inspection. They were observed speaking and playing with children on their level and gave reminders in a soft, quiet voice. All educators were also appropriately dressed for the cold weather, and this allowed them to engage and play with the children in the snow. Attendance clipboards and first aid kits were brought outside.

One new staff file was checked, and documents were easily verified. The file was organized and complete.
