General Comments

Licensing Staff arrived at the Facility to perform a Monitoring Inspection. Upon arrival, the 3- and 4-year-old classes were outside playing. The outdoor environment is organized and has a variety of materials for the children to use. During today's visit the children were seen playing in the sandbox, with trucks, on the slide and on the wooden platform that surrounds a large tree. The Educator let the children know it was time to clean up and they were seen helping put the toys away before lining up to go back inside. A roll call was done before the groups went inside.

Once inside, proper hand washing was observed. The Educator read "All by Myself" while the children took turns washing their hands. The Educator often paused during the story to ask the children questions related to the book, "Can you brush your teeth by yourself?". The Educators were observed engaging with all the children while they ate lunch, crouching down to be at their level. Once lunches were finished the children were seen playing with puzzles, blocks and dolls for quiet time.

A few Educators have switched classrooms and are in the process of getting settled. The rooms are all bright, well organized and inviting. Invitations were seen throughout the room which the children seem to enjoy. In one class a large apple pie sensory bin was set up with cinnamon sticks, rolled oats and felt pieces that could be put together to make an apple pie. Webbing, pictures and children's artwork were displayed in each class. A large binder was seen on the bookshelf which was filled with pictures from guest speakers, science experiments and activities the children had done over the summer. Transition periods in all rooms were smooth and calm. The Educators are attentive to the needs of the children and showed interest in the children's wellbeing.
