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General Comments

Licensing Staff arrived at the facility to conduct the Renewal Inspection. Upon arrival, all classes were playing outside in the fenced in playground. Lunch boxes and water bottles were brought outside as the children were having morning snack outside today. As the children finished eating, lunch boxes were brought back inside and the children engaged in outdoor free play.

The outdoor environment is well maintained and offers a wide variety of play materials, all in good condition. A large section of the playground is shaded by trees. Several wooden storage boxes were observed throughout the playground. The boxes included Fisher Price Little People figures, wooden blocks, balls, shovels, buckets, mixing bowls and utensils. A large shed was set up with a table and chairs for coloring, a bin of costumes and stuffed animals and a bin of books was also observed. Throughout the morning children were observed playing dress up and coloring, baking cakes and bread in the sandbox and playing on the swings.

The transition inside the facility for lunch was smooth. Once inside, hand washing and proper diaper changing procedures were observed. The Educators sang songs with the children as they waited for their turn to wash up for lunch. Cots and napping materials had been set up earlier in the morning so as the children finished eating, they chose a book to bring on their cot as they prepared for quiet time. In the school age classroom, the children were observed playing with Lego and a dollhouse once they had finished eating.

During today's Renewal Inspection, only positive child guidance was observed. The Educators were attentive to the needs of the children and were observed encouraging peers to talk through disagreements. Purposeful planning was observed in each room. Webbing, learning stories, process art and photos of the children with their peers was observed throughout the facility. Files were reviewed on site and contained all required documents.

Licensing staff recommends for renewal.
