General Comments					
Upon Licensing staff arrival, the Operator was tidying up the indoor space prior to the arrival of the children. The Operator cleaned the tables, swept the floor and ensured play material was in its proper place.					
The indoor space was very inviting with children's artwork on display as well as colourful learning posters and activities. Throughout the space, there were multiple Lego stations, wooden blocks, maps, a large doll house with accessories, a piano, art supplies with a large easel, board games and books. When the first bus arrived, the Operator met the children and welcomed them indoors. The children hung up their bookbags in their cubbies and went outdoors to play. The outdoor space was large and fully fenced. Play material such as skipping ropes, sidewalk chalk, a climbing dome, a play structure with slide, balls, badminton rackets and playhouses were all in good condition. The children were excited to see how much their garden plants have grown and to water them as the theme of the week was gardening. The Operator was very engaged in play and conversation with the children and was observed skipping and playing badminton. The children and Operator went back indoors prior to the arrival of the second bus as it started to rain. Once indoors, the children washed their hands and began to make a craft out of popsicle sticks. The Operator sat with the children and positive words of encouragement were heard. When the second bus arrived, again the Operator met the child off the bus and welcomed them indoors. During inspection, files were verified, and all required documentation was present. The parent board was visible, and the evacuation plan was posted. Monthly fire drills, outdoor maintenance checks, cleaning and first aid kit checks are being completed and documented. Also, the Operator inquired about using a hammock in the outdoor space. Hammocks are permitted to be used as per manufacture guidelines, proper swinging clearance and protective surfacing below.
