### General Comments

Licensing Staff arrived at the facility to conduct a Monitoring Inspection. Upon arrival the Operator was preparing the classroom and attendance records before the first group of children were due to arrive. The Operator greeted the children at the bus stop before returning back inside the facility. Each child has their own cubby area with a hook for bookbags and jackets and a bin for other personal belongings.

Once inside, the children put indoor shoes on and washed their hands. Some children sat at the tables to have afternoon snack while others engaged in activities such as looking up coloring sheets they would like to print and preparing the touch and feel box. Several positive changes have been made to the indoor environment since the last Monitoring Inspection. Tables, shelves and a large sensory bin have been moved which allows for children to move freely around the classroom. A new arcade basketball game has also been added since the last Monitoring Inspection. The children were observed playing and taking turns with the new game throughout the afternoon.

The Operator was heard discussing with the children about the plan for this upcoming week, designer week. Materials such as paper people, yarn, markers, magnetic dolls, outfits and jewelry kits were purchased for this week. Some children sat together at a table designing different outfits using yarn and markers on the paper people. Others were observed making creations out of clay and playing a chair stacking game.

Only positive child guidance was observed today. The Operator walked around the classroom, checking in and engaged in conversations with each child, showing a genuine interest in their activities. Staff and child profiles were review on site today and contained all required documents.
