General Comments
<p>Licensing staff arrived at the centre in the morning of February 25, 2021. Covid-19 screening posters are posted on the door where you enter the centre.</p> <p>Child/staff ratios in all classrooms are met according to the Early Childhood Services Act.</p> <p>Educators in all classrooms have completed webs of activities for the week. There were many examples of children's learning posted on the walls in each classroom. In the two year old room there were different kinds of trucks made with handprints and footprints on the wall. The infant room had different farm animal crafts posted on the wall that the children coloured themselves. There was also a shape of an animal with the child's face in the centre for the children to look at and identify with. In the three year old classroom there were pictures on the walls that the children decorated as "cups of hot chocolate" and trucks. In the four year old room there were pictures that the children drew with markers on pieces of construction paper. There was also a craft completed by the children where the educator gave the children pieces of paper cut into shapes to create a snowman and the children put the pieces together to complete the picture.</p> <p>When licensing staff conducted observations in the three year old classroom the children were engaging in a craft where they were given a paper cut-out of a sheep. The educator then proceeded to give the children the glue bottle so they could squeeze out the glue onto their paper in order to glue the cotton balls onto the body of the sheep to emulate wool. The children loved squeezing out the glue onto their paper.</p> <p>As per the Early Childhood Services Act infants shall not be grouped with children of another age group. It was observed that the infants are now napping and eating meals in their own classroom and not combining with the two year old children.</p>
