<p>General Comments</p> <p>Monitoring report performed.. Administrative records were reviewed, child and staff attendance, fire drills, outdoor checklist etc. Just a kind reminder that fire extinguishers need serviced in January. Fire and Health inspections will be required for renewal licensing. Please remind educators they must be tracking their arrivals and departures on their attendance record. Also, please ensure parents are providing reasons for absence and that staff document reason for absence on the attendance record. Babies and preschoolers were observed finishing lunch and going down for naps. a few children started to stir after 1 1/2 hours but they seemed content to lay quietly, though children are permitted to get up and move to the table set up in the nap room to play quietly. I would recommend that quiet table activities are set up before nap so when children wake they can move to that area without disturbing other's naptime. I would also suggest that educators open the curtain at this time on that side of the nap room. The 4's were enjoying a quiet time and playing with puzzles. They were helping each other and talking about the shapes and corner pieces. Later they were involved with playing 'Simon says' and building with lego. I did not observe outdoor play during my visit. It is my understanding they will be going out after snack. I will follow up on our conversation regarding posting illness notices.</p>
