Comments: When conducting the license renewal inspection, licensing staff noted that a purposely planned activity schedule was not being created. Please ensure that a purposely planned activity schedule, based on the children's interests, is being planned prior to the day of implementation.

Comments: In reviewing the monthly emergency and evacuation and fire drill form, licensing staff noted that an evacuation and fire drill was not recorded for February and March. Please ensure that an evacuation and fire drill is conducted and recorded on the appropriate form each month.			
31(3) An operator shall maintain the outdoor play area of a licensed facility to ensure the safety of the children.	31(3)	Apr 26, 2022	
Comments: While licensing staff was inspecting the outdoor play spaces a number of safety hazards were noted. Please ensure any protruding screws and nails are removed from the pergola and garage. Please ensure the gates located on the outdoor play area are secured and not able to pull them open. Please remove the broken window casing located at the back of the garage. Please remove the broken pieces of boards that are behind the garage. Please ensure that the cracked window in the garage is either repaired or boarded up to ensure the safety of the children.			
33(3) An operator of a licensed facility shall complete a monthly review and maintenance plan on all stationary equipment that includes the following information: (a) the review and repair dates; (b) the action required and the action taken; and (c) the name of the staff member who conducted the review.	33(3)	Apr 12, 2022	
Comments: Please ensure a monthly review and maintenance plan is completed on all stationary equipment showing: the review and repair dates; the action required and taken; and the name of the staff completing the review in order to maintain the safety of the children while playing in the outdoor play space.

General Comments

Licensing staff arrived at the licensed facility on April 12, 2022 to conduct the license renewal inspection. The children from all groups, except for babies, were in the 2/3 year old classroom to eat their morning snack. After the children were finished their morning snack, the children and educators dispersed to their assigned classrooms to engage in activities.

The two and three year old children engaged in an Easter painting activity. The materials used in this activity were pre-cut medium sized egg, made out of coloured construction paper, paint and glitter. The children were given a choice of four colours to paint their egg. After painting their egg, the children were offered multi-coloured glitter to add to their painted egg.

Licensing staff observed the educators engaging with the children throughout the license renewal inspection visit. The children were heard laughing and engaging in rich conversation with their educators while observing in each classroom.

While licensing staff was conducting observations in each classroom, it was noted that some water bottles and lunch boxes were labelled however, not all were labelled with the child's name. Once this was brought to the attention of the classroom teacher, the classroom teacher labelled each bottle and lunchbox.

In reviewing the monthly emergency and evacuation and fire drill form, licensing staff noted that an evacuation and fire drill was not recorded for February and March. Please ensure that an evacuation and fire drill is conducted and recorded on the appropriate form every month.

While inspecting the refrigerator located in the kitchen area, it was noted that two bottles were being stored in the fridge. One bottle had a cover and was labelled with the child's name however, the second bottle was not labelled and did not have a cover. Please ensure that all bottles are labelled and have a cover when being stored in the refrigerator.
