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| <p>General Comments</p> <p>Children in the 3 year old room were engaged in a structured butterfly craft with their educator. The children were patiently waiting as the educator put the paint on the cut-out butterflies and asked them to fold it over and rub the paint to create a design. The educator then wrote the name of each child on them and pinned them on a line in the room. Children were aware of the routine in this room, putting away their chairs and getting a book as children used the washroom in preparation to go outside.</p> <p>The educator cleaned the table as the children were transitioning. Crafts are posted throughout each room and a variety of resources are available in each room with a few books on racks and shelves. Markers and paper were observed in the three's and four's room.</p> <p>The educator in the 2's room allows the children to have a run before setting up the cots to go outside. Eleven cots were set up in the 2's room. Ensure there is at least 46 cm between cots. The administrator stated that the 2's space has always been the nap area with sometimes up to 14 children napping in the room.</p> <p>The children all went outside for an hour in the morning enjoying the play structure, ride-on cars, chalk, bikes with helmets, and the large play space. Two children, an infant and two-year-old played with their educator on the porch in the infant play space. Two children have recently turned two and there is no space yet in the 2-year-old room. Large sails are provided as shade for the infant area and set up as needed. There is natural shade in the outdoor preschool play area from the building and trees, as well the shed is opened to allow children to independently choose resources and get out of the sun.</p> <p>The children that didn't nap played games in the school-age space with the administrator and a co-op student. The children were also eager to go outside and play again after the games.</p> |
