Comments: The fence has a broken board and a hole in it on the preschool playground and some rotten boards around the pea gravel, as well the wooden fence is leaning. The afterschool outdoor play area has some rotten boards on the floor with the climbing wall and on the ramps on the gazebo. Outdoor play spaces must be safe for children at all times.

General Comments
<p>Children played outside this morning for an hour. Children dressed themselves independently and requested help, if needed. The children enjoyed play on the play structure, riding bikes and ride-on toys, and building with wooden blocks. One of the educators took photos of the children at play documenting their learning. Some attention is needed in the outdoor play space to correct some rotten boards and the fence.</p> <p>Children all sat together for lunch in the main room. They were able to open their snacks with some help from educators and peers. Children and the educators engaged in discussion about their home lives as they ate. Children washed their hands before and after snack. Once children finished their lunch, they took a book from the shelf to sit at the table and wait for their friends. Children would share what they were reading with their friends who were still eating.</p> <p>Crafts were posted on the wall and photos of the children were posted at the children's height on the wall and they enjoyed looking at these photos and pointing out photos of themselves and their friends.</p> <p>The preschool age group use the large school-age space after lunch while the younger children go down for nap.</p>
