General Comments
<p>Licensing staff arrived at the licensed facility to conduct the Follow-Up License Renewal Inspection.</p> <p>Child-to-staff ratios were in compliance according to the Early Childhood Services Act.</p> <p>Licensing staff noted that mark-making and craft supplies were accessible to the children to engage with in each classroom.</p> <p>The 2 and 3-year-old children were combined in the 3-year-old classroom until after snack time. After snack time all children went to their assigned classrooms.</p>

## General Comments

Before snack time, the 4-year-old children were having a game of UNO. The children were able to match colours, numbers and could follow the direction of the cards on their own with minimal assistance from the educator.

The cabinet where the cleaning supplies are stored was locked and not accessible to the children receiving services at the licensed facility.

The icy walkway leading from the gate to the outdoor preschool play environment was salted and the ice was melting and breaking up and no longer a safety hazard.

While licensing staff was onsite at the facility, the Director placed a flexible daily schedule at the entrance of the facility where the school-aged program is located, for all parents to see.
