Upon arrival, children were engaged in a food activity as they are learning about the food groups. They were able to choose pictures from the different foods to put on a paper plate. This activity-initiated conversation, choice and interest in the different food groups. The educators then did a circle time and the children recited a poem with actions and listened to a book being read. They also had active time. The morning ended with a goodbye song and preparation to go home.

The children have a good rapport with the educators. The relationship between the educator and children is respectful with many conversations between the two. Expectations are clearly defined by the educators with a solid routine and gentle reminders are given when the children need them. The educators demonstrated positive child guidance such as gentle reminders, encouragement and positive reinforcement. They are very kind and loving towards the children. Only positive child guidance was seen at the time of visit.

There are many materials for the children to choose from. The grocery store that is set up for the children compliments their current learning interests. There are a variety of foods and a cash register set up with photocopied color money, fake credit and debit cards to enhance their experience.

Licensing staff was able to verify all documentation for licensing purposes easily. The filing system is organized and complete.
