<p>All non-compliances were met at time of follow-up visit.</p> <p>Staff files are now complete with all necessary information.</p> <p>Operator purchased new cots for all children in attendance.</p> <p>All toxics are and will remain locked.</p> <p>Shade for the outdoor play space has been fixed.</p> <p>Broken toys have been removed from outdoor play space.</p> <p>Containers or napkins are being used for food while the children eat.</p> <p>High chairs and play pens are no longer being used in the two year old room for children of this age.</p> <p>Licensing staff advised Operator that more defined learning centres will need to be apparent in the preschool outdoor play space. These centres must have varying accessories and set up in a manner that the children are invited to play. This was seen more visibly in the indoor play space at time of visit especially in the two year old room. Your quality assurance monitor will support and guide you through proper room and environment set up on monitoring visits.</p>
