Comments: The old wood has been replaced and there is a new shed. There has been ongoing work to the playground and it will continue for the near future.

Comments: Due to continuing work to the playground, children will not be permitted to play on the equipment that does not have enough protective surfacing or anchoring. This will be required, and construction is currently ongoing.			

General Comments
<p>Upon my arrival, I observed the children playing in the classroom. They had a chance for free play and there were opportunities for both individual and group play. The children were busy playing with blocks, foosball, doll houses, Mr Potato heads, and some were reading. There were sufficient materials for all children and the room has been set up nicely into different centers. There were learning stories on the wall that tied the activities back to the curriculum and they were well written. Children's work was also displayed on the walls.</p> <p>I then looked at program planning. There has been lots of programming for the summer. Each week has a theme and has activities planned for each theme. Themes include biking, nature/hiking, science, Christmas in July, water, art, and sports. One activity was a full day trip to Saint Andrews where the children went to the aquarium among other activities in the area. This week is career week and everyday they have had a guest come in to talk about their career. They have already had military and police come in. Today is Border Services and the rest of the week is blood services and fire department. Each week they have regular activities such as open swim and swimming lessons, archery lessons for the older children, and golf.</p> <p>The playground continues to have ongoing renovations. The old wood has been replaced and there is a new shed. The dome still needs anchoring and protective surfacing and children will not be permitted to play on it until the work can be completed. The children can still play on the other areas that meet regulations. When all playground renovations have been completed please advise me.</p>
