General Comments							
Purpose of inspection on this date was to complete a regular monitoring inspection. Early afterschool were observed using the classroom bike, foosball table, connect four games and sitting on the couch. During the time of the inspection, some children did not settle into an activity. To help children feel more engaged with their environment, materials in the room should be replenished and can be changed based on the children's interests. Prepare an engaging learning environment that includes novel, interesting materials will provoke curiosity and exploration among the children. Clubs provide another way for school age children to learn about new topics in an interesting and in-depth way. Club topics should be based on the interests of children and involve the completion of a project relating to the topic. Some examples of school age clubs could be a Cooking Club, a Photography Club, a Rock and Mineral Collectors Club, a Lego Club, a Jewelry Making Club, a Paint by number Club and so on. While licensing staff was speaking with educator in later afterschool room about clubs, children gave many ideas on clubs they may be interested in forming, these conversations can be used towards building on the children's current interests and decided what materials to add to the room. The outdoor play area was observed to be well maintained. Early Afterschool children enjoyed materials such as shovels, buckets and soccer balls. Children were all dressed appropriately for the weather. Late afterschool room stayed inside on this date and enjoyed a variety of activities in the room. The saucer
