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| <p>General Comments</p> <p>Licensing staff arrived at the facility to conduct the annual renewal inspection.</p> <p>At the time of arrival, the children had not yet returned from school. During this period, staff and children's files were reviewed and verified.</p> <p>The environment was prepared with developmentally appropriate invitations to play for school-aged children. Activities included a "spring secret code," paint-by-numbers, and a board game. The space was well organized and reflected a spring theme, with children's recent artwork displayed throughout.</p> <p>The downstairs area was also organized, with a variety of materials set up and ready for use, including Lego, puzzles, dollhouses, large blocks, and an art station. These materials were appropriate for the age group and supported a range of play opportunities.</p> <p>Upon arrival, the children transitioned directly to the outdoor play area. Outdoors, children engaged in a variety of activities, including using the swings, playing baseball, exploring the sand pit, climbing on play structures, and socializing in small groups. Children also had access to eat at the picnic tables as they pleased.</p> <p>Educators were observed actively engaging with the children and providing encouragement during their baseball game. Appropriate supervision was maintained, and required ratios were met at all times throughout the visit. Only positive child guidance strategies were observed. Fire evacuation drills are conducted on a monthly basis.</p> <p>Licensing staff recommends the program for renewal.</p> |
