General Comments

Pre-planned programming and evidence of the children's learning is consistent throughout each classroom. The educators have posted many pictures of the children doing their activities in the classroom and have completed many learning stories. Many of the educators have posted the children's family pictures at their level and also a cubed box with pictures posted on it was observed. It is evident that the educators take pride in their work. Some of the learning stories and children's names to label the cribs were in picture frames. The educators are also keeping some of the children's experiences in portfolios.

There has been a lot of materials added to the outdoor play space since opening. This includes but is not limited to dramatic play where there is a dirt pile and teepee to stretch their imaginations. There are balance beams, excavators, a car built by scrap wood and materials, sensory stations and planters where the children were able to experience planting and cultivation in the summer months. One of the educators advised me that they had planted tomatoes, green bell peppers, cucumbers and yellow beans. Shelter sandboxes have also been added to the playgrounds. The administrator advised me that the children have also experienced the school's outdoor classroom.

The educators have set up their classrooms in ways that work for the children that they have in their care. Some of the learning centres include blocks, books, kitchens, dolls, Legos, blocks and art materials.

The filing system is meticulous, and the educators and administrator are using all required forms and documents for licensing.

I can now recommend facility for licensing.
