Comments: Two new employees do not have their first aid course. Proof of registration must be sent to inspector. These staff members cannot be left alone with a group of children until the course is completed.

Comments: Several staff members have not yet started the 90 hour course. New staff must be registered and proof of registration must be added to their file.

Comments: During the visit there was Tylenol in a bag in the cupboard with amounts prescribed but no name on the bottle/bag. All medications must be labelled with the child's name.			

General Comments
<p>Visit to the facility to complete the annual inspection. Ratio was respected during the visit.</p> <p>There is a small rock climbing wall in the outdoor play area, recommending this be reviewed to ensure it meets CSA standards.</p> <p>Several medications were not under lock and key. This was addressed with the educators and medications were locked during the visit. If medication is needed outdoors/nearby, recommending a portable lock box. All medications aside from an epi pen should be locked at all times. When medications is administered, on-going records must be kept.</p> <p>During the visit non-napping preschool aged children were required to stay on their nap mat for more than 30 minutes. It was discussed with the educators and director that this is not permitted and rest periods must meet individual needs. After a period of 20-30 minute quiet time, children who do not sleep are allowed to get up and play quietly.</p> <p>Discussions regarding pool ratio were had with staff and the director. Pool ratio must be respected at all times. Recommending all staff read section 10.10 in the operators manual regarding pool use and safety.</p> <p>Discussed with staff children with additional needs, recommending assessments with early learning team.</p> <p>Discussed with educators and director emergency care plan and on-going treatment forms. These forms must be fully completed. Recommending the director and all staff review appendix 5 and 6 in the operators manual.</p> <p>Discussions were had regarding outdoor outings. Children did not go outside in the morning as they went to the pool. Facility must ensure children go outside once every four hours. Staff must also ensure children are dressed appropriately for the weather.</p> <p>Children's files must be reviewed to ensure that full addresses are indicated for emergency contacts and people who have permission to pick up children. Medical practitioner information must be reviewed as well as Medicare information.</p> <p>Learning stories are presently being worked on for each child. Recommended that educators document their observations and programming and plan more activities according to the children's interests.</p> <p>Observations: Upon arrival preschool aged children were getting ready to go to the pool. After the pool they had lunch nap and quiet time. When the children woke up they had snack. School age children arrived stayed outside for activities.</p>
