<p>Visit to the facility to complete renewal inspection. Ratio was respected during the visit.</p> <p>Discussion with administrator and educators regarding a structure made of pallets in the outdoor play area. It was suggested that it be moved to the area with pea gravel if the children want to use it to climb. Moving the structure to the pea gravelled area will ensure there is protective surfacing in case of a fall. Educators confirm that children are not using it to climb currently.</p> <p>Children were into free play when I arrived, then they went outdoor to play and returned to have lunch. After lunch, children washed their hands and had a rest period.</p>
