- -Visit at the center for an unannounced monitoring inspection
- -Ratio was respected during the visit
- -Administrator and educators are holding a valid first aid certificate and a valid CPR certificate
- -The administrator and more than 50% of educators are holding a one-year Early Childhood Education Certificate or training that is equivalent
- -An inclusive environment is provided for all children
- -Daily activities include purposely planned and documented programing such has, time and space for and a free choice of play experiences. Indoor and outdoor opportunities for physical activity, individual and group experiences, opportunities for various forms of literacy. Opportunities to express creativity and interests, to explore the arts and sciences and to experience accomplishment and success. Opportunities to problem solving and to develop trusting, respectful and supportive relationships.
- -Easily accessible space is provided for personal belongings, that space is identified with the child's name and is separated for each child.
- -Center has the proper number of functioning and available toilets and sinks
- -Steps or platforms are provided to allow children to reach regular sized toilets or sinks
- -Posted in a visible and prominent place in the facility are these required documents: The license, inspection report, daily routine, weekly menu, evacuation procedures, name of operator, name and telephone number of QA Monitor and inspector, life-threatening allergies, a notice to inform parents of the existence of a communicable disease (if applicable)
- In all rooms, evidence of purposeful planning based on children's interest and learning, webbing, invitation, photos and learning stories were posted.
- -Rooms are inviting, material is versatile and provides space for children to learn, explore and get creative -The entry way for the outside space needs to be cleaned, snow must not obstruct the passage to the fenced-in space. At this moment it is possible to open the door, but the snow prevents the door from fully opening. During the visit the passage to the playground was cleaned.

Observations: When getting at the center all groups the twos were napping, when getting into the room it was obvious that the children's interest at this moment is hockey, learning stories, webbing and zones were

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reflecting that interest. The three-year-old were doing a science experiment with snakes and talking about hibernation and were snakes goes during the winter. The fours were doing a puzzle has a team and another group were into building very high towers with blocs.
