General Comments

- -Morning visit to learning center for an unexpected monitoring inspection
- -Ratio was respected during the visit
- -Children's guidance is done in a respectful and positive way
- -Individual space is provided for diapers, creams and wipes for each child who is not toilet trained. The changing table is equipped with a safety strap and a non-absorbent layer. Changing area is separated from the food preparation and is located one meter or less from a sink. Children are always supervised during diaper changing.
- -Posted in a visible and prominent place in the facility are the following documents: The license, inspection report, orders for compliance, daily routine, evacuation procedures, name of administrator, name and telephone number of QA Monitor and Inspector Life-threatening allergies and a notice to inform parents of the existence of a communicable disease.
- -The parent is being asked to notify the operator/director the reason why the child is absent, whether it's sickness or another reason
- -When a child who becomes ill, he/she is supervised and separated from the other children. That child is to be picked up within one hour of notification to parents.
- -Management of potential illness forms are completed as required, discussion with the operator on appendix 11 & 12 in the operator's manual.
- -Parents are advised when a child has a communicable disease or illness, center does use the notice of illness form (appendix 13, in the operator's manual)
- -We also talk about appendix 14-Managing illness in ELC facilities- parent's/guardian's role.
- -The administrator and educators have a valid first aid certificate and a valid CPR certificate
- -50% of staff have their ECE or the equivalent.
- -2 new staff members were registered for their 90 hours (Introduction to Early Childhood). One employee is now into her training ending in April 2024 and the second employee will start in July 2024

Observations: When arriving at the center the two's were working on an Easter project and were getting ready for their parents to come in for a special activity the next day. The three's were playing outside, got ready for lunch, they are also expecting the parents to come in for an Easter activity tomorrow. Parents were invited into the four -year-old room to work on an Easter project.
