General Comments

- -Unexpected morning visit to the establishment for a monitoring inspection
- -Ratio was respected in all groups during the visit
- -Posted in a visible and prominent place in the facility are the following documents: The license, inspection report, orders for compliance, daily routine, evacuation procedures, name of administrator, name and telephone number of QA Monitor and inspector Life threatening allergies and when it applies a notice to inform parents of the existence of a communicable disease.
- -The administrator as well as all educators have a valid first aid certificate
- -Four new employees are registered to their 90h-Introduction to early childhood
- -The administrator and 50% of the staff have their one-year Early childhood education certificate
- -Medication are locked and stored in each classroom and is inaccessible to children
- -Medication used for anaphylactic shock (EPIPEN) are stored safely (inaccessible to children), identified well and easily accessible for staff
- -During the visit, it was observed that all educators are engaged with children at their level providing support and having conversations.
- -Classrooms are the designated napping spaces with the center. Each napping child has a cot that is appropriate for their height and is in good repair
- -Administrator and staff confirm that all bedding material is washed weekly by the parents
- -Each child has an easily accessible space to store their personal belongings, which is labeled with their name and used only for the intended child.
- -Diaper changing station is found in all washrooms that are found in each classroom, individual space is provided for diapers and changing necessities. The changing table is equipped with a safety strap and covered with a non-absorbent layer, it is separated from the food preparation and is located one meter or less from a sink and children are always supervised during diaper changing.
- -Diaper changing procedures were revisited with the staff, washing their hands and the children's thoroughly to maintain proper hygiene and prevent the spread of germs.
- -Diaper changing station is located one meter or less from a sink
- -It was discussed with the operator and administrator different ways to provide a time during the week for staff to have planning time.
- -One toilet in the four-year-old room is broken, it will be fixed this weekend.

General Comments

-In all rooms, evidence of purposeful planning based on children's interest and learning, webbing, invitation, photos and learning stories were posted.

Observations: When arriving at the center the two-year-old were painting with cars and dinosaurs, the three's were playing with a water table while discussing healthy food and occasional food choices and the four-years-old were just finishing practicing their songs for the Christmas show. No group went outside this morning because some construction was being done in the playground.
