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General Comments -Morning visit to the establishment for an unexpected monitoring inspection -Ratio was respected during the visit -When acetaminophen is administered to a child, the consent form is signed by the parent and kept into the children file. -Medication is locked in a cabinet in each washroom and inaccessible to children -Medication used for anaphylactic shock (EPIPEN) are easy to access for staff, but stored safely (inaccessible to children) in the classroom that is designated to the child -During the visit, it was observed that children are guided through discussion. Requests are made respectfully, and staff supports the children when conflicts arise, supporting them in reaching a mutually agreeable resolution. -Diaper changing station is found in all washrooms within the center; individual space is provided for diapers and changing necessities. The changing table is equipped with a safety strap and covered with a non-absorbent layer, it is separated from the food preparation and is located one meter or less from a sink and children are always supervised during diaper changing. -Infants are supervised at all times when eating or drinking -Infant bottles are stored with a cover in the refrigerator, labeled with the child's name and only used for the intended child -Allergy information on any child is posted in the food preparation area -Drinking water is provided throughout the day -Food brought from home is labeled with the child's name and refrigerated or has an ice pack as required -A first-aid kit and a telephone are available on-site, as well as during excursions outside of the daycare premises. Observations: When arriving at the center, the two's and the infants are playing outside, they had snacks just before heading outside. The three's and the four were in a free play period and were getting ready to go play outside.
