General Comments

- Visit to the learning center for an unexpected monitoring inspection
- Ratio was respected during the visit
- Daily activities into the center shows purposely planned and documented programming that gives children, Time, and space for a free choice of play experiences, indoor and outdoor opportunities for physical activity either individually or in a group. Children have opportunities for various forms of literacy and to express creativity and interests, to explore the arts and sciences and to experience accomplishment and success. They have opportunities to problem solve and to develop trusting, respectful and supportive relationships.
- Each napping child has a cot or nap mat that is appropriate for their height
- Each cot is stored so there is no contact with another napping equipment or are disinfected on both sides after each use
- Each child under 15 months has a designated crib or playpen that meets the Cribs, Cradles and Bassinets Regulations.
- All nap equipment is washable and non-absorbent
- The outdoor play area. Is maintained safe and free of hazards, has more than one surface to permit different types of play and has at least 10% shade.
- The dome climber that is outside the fenced in playgrounds will not be used until surfacing is added, director will look into the manufacturer manual to confirm the amount of surfacing that needs to be added.
- Outdoor play area materials and equipment are varied and in sufficient quantity for all children present
- First-aid kit and telephone are accessible on the premises and on each outing
- Educators are using the curriculum in the language the service is provided
- Proof of the professional learning hours is on premises, some educators do not have the full 10 hours, but they are working on it, and it will be done before their renewal date.
- Quality improvement plan is implanted by the operator

Observations: During the visit, all groups went outside. Some went on a walk and saw a waterfall. In each classroom documentation shows the children's interest and project they are working on. Yesterday the preschool and the junior preschool had a bar-b-q for Father's Day.
