### General Comments

- Morning visit to the establishment for an unexpected monitoring inspection
- During the visit, ratio child-to-staff is maintained and respected in the same age and mixed age groups
- All required documents are found on the parent board which is posted on the first floor where infants cubbies are and in all rooms where cubbies are found.
- The administrator as well as all educators have a valid first aid certificate
- Portfolio which highlights children's learning and development are on the top of the cubbies for certain rooms, they are available for families to go through them daily, staff confirms that they do bring the portfolios into the classroom to create the opportunities for children to revisit, explore their learning.
- During the visit, it was observed that all educators are engaged with children at their level providing support and having conversations.
- The designated napping spaces within the center is the classrooms for children between 15 months to 4 years-old and a separate room for infants 0-15 months.
- Each napping child has a cot that is appropriate for their height
- Infants that are less than 15 months has a designated crib or playpen which meets cribs, playpen regulations.
- Toxic products, and cleaning supplies are locked under key and are inaccessible to children
- Children's indoor play area is safe and clean
- Material and equipment proposed to children in the indoor play area are easily accessible on low, open shelves. It is varied and in sufficient quantity for all children present.

Observations: When arriving at the center, preschool children were playing outside. Senior infants were drawing on a black board and junior infants were exploring with a play tray full of different loose parts. After playing outside preschool kids came in and got ready for lunch and the youngest transitioned to nap time.
