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<p>General Comments</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Morning visit to the establishment for an unexpected monitoring inspection -In all group ratio was respected during the visit -Posted at the two-front entrance in the cubbies area are the following documents: The license, inspection report, orders for compliance, daily routine, evacuation procedures, name of administrator, name and telephone number of QA Monitor and inspector - Life threatening allergies -When it applies a notice to inform parents of the existence of a communicable disease is posted on entrance doors. -The following administrative records are maintained on site: Financial records, daily attendance of children and staff, monthly emergency evacuation fire drills, smoke alarm, smoke detectors and fire extinguisher inspection and maintenance records -Monthly emergency evacuation and fire drills are completed -A monthly review and maintenance plan is completed on all stationary equipment but daily staff does a check up of the playground -During the visit, it was observed that all educators are engaged with children at their level providing support and having conversations. Open-end questions are asked and guidance is given in a respectful and kind way -Children's indoor play area is safe and clean. - Material and equipment proposed to children in the indoor play area are easily accessible on low, open shelves. It is varied and in sufficient quantity for all children present. -In all rooms, evidence of purposeful planning based on children's interest and learning, invitation, photos and learning stories were posted. -Toxic products, and cleaning supplies are locked under key and are inaccessible to children -Communicable public health poster have been given to the administrator <p>Observations: When arriving at the center all children were outside. Preschool children came in with their mail that has picked up, they are working on worldwide Valentin project, they have been receiving Valentin's from all over the world. The thee's are working on a heritage project, while the two's are all about love and Valentin's. The infants have been exploring a lot with any kind of sensory play. All group ate lunch and the youngest ones all went down for a nap.</p>
