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<p>General Comments</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Late-morning visit to the establishment for an unexpected monitoring inspection -Ratio was respected during the visit -The administrator as well as all educators have a valid first aid certificate -The administrator and more than 50% of the staff have their one-year Early childhood education certificate -Medications are locked in the staff washroom upstairs, in the kitchen and in a storage space in the basement all are inaccessible to children -During the visit, it was observed that all educators are engaged with children at their level providing support and having conversations. Rocking children to sleep and comforting before nap time was seen into all napping rooms. -Toxic products, and cleaning supplies are locked under key and are inaccessible to children -Each child has an easily accessible space to store their personal belongings, which is labeled with their name and used only for the intended child. -Outdoor play area consists of more than one surface to permit different types of play -Outdoor material is varied and in sufficient quantity for all children present -Outdoor play area is maintained safe and free of hazards -The outdoor play area has at least 0.45m² of shade for each child based on the maximum number of children that can be accommodated in the outdoor play area -In all rooms and on top of the cubbies learning stories were posted showing children's interest and learning. <p>Observations: When arriving at the center younger children were finishing their lunch and getting ready for nap time. The older preschoolers were outside playing.</p>
