### General Comments

- Visit to the learning center for an unexpected monitoring inspection
- Ratio was respected during the visit
- Toxic products, chemical products and cleaning supplies are locked and inaccessible to children
- Individual space is provided for diapers, creams and wipes for each child who is not toilet trained. The changing table is equipped with a safety strap and a non-absorbent layer. Changing area is separated from the food preparation and is located one meter or less from a sink. Children are always supervised during diaper changing.
- An inclusive environment is provided for all children
- Children's guidance is done in a respectful and positive way
- Indoor environment provides a space that is safe and clean. The material is varied and in sufficient quantity for all children present, easily accessible on low, open shelves.
- Educators are using the curriculum in the language in which services are provided
- Proof on premises that educators have completed 10 hours of professional development per year.
- The operator has implemented and is monitoring the quality improvement plan.
- Throughout the center documentation posted on the walls is showing the children's interest, ex: the infants are starting to paint on and easel which opens a new window of opportunity. The two's are into songs and frogs and still loves a book about a bird. The three's are into salmons, they are learning all about their cycle and the four' s have learned on how to do paper, they talking about recycling and how they can help our earth.

Observations: When arriving at the center the two's were looking into books, they were laughing and chatting about what was going on in the book. The infant's were getting ready for lunch. The three's and fours were all eating and chatting about their families, their favorite book and how much they enjoyed their meal.
