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| <p>General Comments</p> <p>I was screened and signed in at the front office. In the classroom I saw lots of proper handwashing by the educators and the children and COVID guidelines continue to be followed. This is the second last day of the year before they close for summer and the children and educators had a discussion about what they will do in the summer.</p> <p>There were small scrapbooks made for each child by the educators that will be sent home on their last day, tomorrow. The scrapbooks were personalized and documented the activities the children participated in over the past school year. Each one also highlighted accomplishments of each child and pictures accompanied every story.</p> <p>Today I saw the children have circle time, snack, and free play before participating in a collaborative art activity. Transitions between activities were well managed. The educators kept the children occupied during transitions with songs and activities. I saw a lot of positive child guidance during my visit and the educators demonstrated gentle reminders, kneeling to talk with children, active listening while children were talking, and positive reinforcement. One of the educators read the children a book, and made it an interactive experience with children having the chance to ask questions or comment on the content of the book. Each child had a chance to talk, and the educators ensured that each child who wanted to contribute to the conversation did so.</p> <p>The program appears to run very well.</p> |
