Educators need to be continuously adding to the children's environment as their interests evolve. Educators were observed speaking kindly to the children during today's inspection. The preschool children were enjoying a game of BINGO and some of the school aged children were observed building Lego houses and creating snowflakes. Children were observed indoors and outside today.
