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General Comments

Monitoring Inspection:

Children and educators in the preschool rooms were observed engaged in a variety of activities this morning including music and movement, outdoor play, block play and dramatic play. Purposeful planning is evident through documentation displayed. Invitations are set-up within each interest centre and materials that have been added to environments that support the children's current interests (food, Fall, Halloween, and transportation). Literacy opportunities have been added throughout the rooms. Local flyers, menus, words, lists and recipes are accessible to children. Age-appropriate loose parts and items from nature have been added to indoor play areas for the children to explore.

During Monitoring Inspection this morning, the building was evacuated twice due to an alarm malfunction. All staff and children were observed to gather at their meeting place, attendance was taken, and educators were observed comforting children and engaging in meaningful conversations while they waited to return inside.

School-age children were observed engaged in a variety of activities this afternoon including outdoor play, open-ended art, and dramatic play. Each environment is set-up with a variety of materials for the children to explore. The children in Group 2 are currently interested in vehicles, they were observed using cardboard boxes to build cars for their "drive in movie".

Hand washing routines observed after outdoor play, before lunch and at arrival from school. Vegetable soup, crackers, egg salad and tuna salad sandwiches with milk were served for lunch today. Apples and crackers were served for afternoon snack. Monthly fire drills are documented. New staff file (4) review was completed.
