General Comments

Monitoring Inspection - Child Care:

Children and educators observed engaged in a variety of activities this morning including building with blocks, mark making, dramatic play, stories, outdoor play, exploring stickers and Duplo. Educators observed engaging in meaningful conversations with the children at their level. Educators were observed encouraging children to problem solve independently.

QA Monitor discussed art materials with administrator during inspection as materials have become depleted and there are not materials on site for staff to replenish their art areas. A variety of open-ended art materials must be accessible to the children. Art materials to be replenished daily. Examples of materials to include, but are not limited to variety of paper in colours, textures and sizes, paint, paint brushes, paint rollers, mark making materials, glue, tape, feathers, tissue paper, cardboard tubes, fabric, yarn, ribbon, recycled items, items collected from nature, collage materials, etc.

Purposeful planning is evident through documentation on planning sheets, invitations and materials added to the environments to support the children's current interests (nature, bugs, babies, doctor and animals). The learning stories that are displayed throughout each room have not been updated since May/June 2025. Documentation displayed is to reflect current interests and learning experiences. It was determined that the educators are no longer permitted to have documentation time throughout the week.

Handwashing routines were observed.

Monthly fire drills are documented.

Daily attendance records are accurate and reflect all children present. Child-to-staff ratio was observed to be met during Monitoring Inspection.

New staff file (1) review was completed, all required documents are in place.

A Change in Service Application is to be submitted to QA Monitor for the change in administrator.

After school program was not observed today.
