General Comments

The Quality Assurance Monitor is on site to conduct a monitoring inspection.

The Quality Assurance Monitor is present during nap time, lunch, indoor play, and outdoor play.

During indoor play, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed the children engaging in a variety of activities, including reading books, playing with Paw Patrol figurines, playing with Mrs. Potato Head, building with wooden blocks, colouring, and practising cutting paper with scissors under the supervision of educators. The Quality Assurance Monitor also observed the staff members reading books to the children and interacting with them through their chosen activities. The children who no longer nap was observed participating in quiet activities during the rest time.

During outdoor play, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed the children sliding down a small hill using a slide, shovelling snow, and creating snowballs.

The Quality Assurance Monitor verified these items:

- Ratio and maximum number of children
- Daily routine
- Child guidance
- Premises
- Rest area
- Safety
- Transportation

The Quality Assurance Monitor had a discussion with the administrator regarding the 10 hours of professional learning that eligible staff members must complete by March 31, 2026. The administrator stated that eligible staff members have completed or are currently in the process of completing their required hours.
